**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE IN THE SPRING  
SEMESTER 2017**

**Position:** University of Hong Kong, School of Biological Sciences opens a call for three (3) students in the field of Food and Nutrition Sciences for a student exchange in **University of Eastern Finland, Kuopio, Finland.**

Founded in 1972, The University of Eastern Finland is a multidisciplinary university, which offers teaching in more than 100 major subjects. The University is one of the largest universities in Finland, and home to approximately 15,000 students and 2,800 members of staff. The University is the largest provider of medical education in Finland.

**Timing:** January. – June 2017 (5-6 months, spring semester 2017)

**Grant:** A grant will be awarded to the selected three students, including airfare (1000 €), accommodation 300 €/month and a daily allowance 400 €/month. Students will be assisted with the accommodation by the host university. The students need to pay for their airfare first and make up the claim upon arrival to the host University.

**Eligibility:** Enrollment in Year 3 or 4 with a minimum CGPA of 3.2. The final selection is based on CGPA, interview and previous exchange (priority will be given to candidates who met the CGPA and interview requirement but did not participate previously in exchange programs).

**The application period:** Call is open until 1 September 2017. Send your application to [elnezami@hku.hk](mailto:elnezami@hku.hk). A Letter of Motivation and a transcript of records should be included. Most eligible applicants will be interviewed before the final decision. **Further information:** Course descriptions for the Spring semester 2017 are attached.
